COVID-19 Plan Updates – 2021-2022



**The following policies and procedures will be reviewed regularly and are subject to change as necessary or as required.*

Social Distancing

- Spacing requirements and modified layouts in classrooms may be relaxed and left at the discretion of the educator, distancing efforts may be promoted

Drinking Fountains

- Drinking fountains and water bottle fill stations will be made available

Handwashing/Sanitization

- Healthy hygiene practices will continue to be promoted at all times. Frequent handwashing and sanitizing of spaces including desks and common areas will be practiced

COVID-19 Vaccine

- The COVID-19 vaccine is optional, at the discretion of each family

Transportation

- Carline, lobby, daycare, and busing may be used for arrival and pick up
- Wyneken will continue to follow North Adams Community Schools requirements/mandates for bus transportation of students

Remote Learning

- Remote learning may take place if students or classrooms are required to quarantine at home due to COVID-19 or contact tracing

Food Distribution

- CDC and Indiana Departments of Health and Education recommendations will be followed concerning the serving/distribution of food

Masks

- Masks will no longer be required
- A parents wish for their child to wear a mask at all times regardless of the activity should send a note indicating this desire to the school
- Masks for faculty and staff are encouraged for close interactions when adequate social distancing is not possible.

Extra-Curricular/Co-Curricular Events

- Wyneken will follow necessary protocols and requirements concerning extra-curricular/co-curricular activities

COVID-19 Positive Individuals

- Protocols concerning those who have tested positive for COVID-19 will remain the same. The school will heed the advice of the Adams County Department of Health, contact trace, and quarantine as necessary
