password, agreeing to terms and conditions. You will receive a message to check your email inbox and click on the link in the email. Click on My Account and use your email address and password to proceed to the next step. Click on the Edit Kroger Community Rewards information and input your Kroger Plus card number. Enter NPO number 10460 or name of organization Wyneken, or select organization from list and confirm. To verify you are enrolled correctly, you will see organization name (Wyneken) on right side of page. REMEMBER, purchases will not count for Wyneken until after you register your Kroger Plus card(s). Members must swipe their registered Kroger Plus card or enter their Alternate ID when shopping for each purchase to count. If you don't have a Kroger Plus card, ask a cashier or at the service desk how to get one.

<u>Dress Code Policy:</u> Shorts and capris may be worn to school <u>from April 1st to the end of the school year</u>. The guidelines for the wearing of shorts/skirts/capris are as follows: Shorts, dresses and skirts must be at least fingertip length when a student is standing with arms down by his/her side; Shirts, tops and blouses must be long enough to cover the abdomen *at all times*; Shorts and capris must be hemmed with no frayed edges; Tight fitting pants, shorts, leggings and capris may only be worn if covered by a longer skirt, shorts or top of fingertip length. If a student dresses inappropriately, he/she will be required to make a change of clothing. The student will be allowed to call home for a change of clothing or a change of clothing will be provided for the student. The student will not be allowed in the classroom until they are wearing acceptable clothing.
