Dress Code Policy: Shorts and capris may be worn to school from April 1st to the end of the school year. The guidelines for the wearing of shorts/skirts/capris are as follows: Shorts, dresses and skirts must be at least fingertip length when a student is standing with arms down by his/her side; Shirts, tops and blouses must be long enough to cover the abdomen *at all times*; Shorts and capris must be hemmed with no frayed edges; Tight fitting pants, shorts, leggings and capris may only be worn if covered by a longer skirt, shorts or top of fingertip length. If a student dresses inappropriately, he/she will be required to make a change of clothing. The student will be allowed to call home for a change of clothing or a change of clothing will be provided for the student. The student will not be allowed in the classroom until they are wearing acceptable clothing.
